IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING SHOES

- Black leather or vinyl lace up or Velcro shoes that cover the whole foot and have no other colours are the only shoes to be worn at St Peter's
- Dunlop volleys and girls Tbar and bar shoes are not permitted.



EARRINGS

Coloured nail polish, accessories and jewellery are not to be worn with the school uniform, (exceptions: wristwatch, one gold/silver stud in each ear.)

Hair is to be kept clean and brushed and be of one's natural colour. Suitable fringe length is above eyebrow. Hair, collar length or longer, should be tied with blue or white elastic hair bands, ribbons, scrunchies or small bows (Jojo bows are not permitted). Undercuts and cuts below Gauge 3 are not permitted and stencil cuts and/or tracks are not acceptable.

SWIMMING UNIFORM

All students will have swimming lessons at St Peter's Aquatic Centre during the school year.

Swimming Uniforms include:

- Unisex swim short
- Girls' full piece
- Rash shirt - which is compulsory for all students

St Peter's swim wear is compulsory for all students, including caps and bags





Swimming caps and swimming bags are available in the house colours.



The wearing of the school uniform promotes pride in both the school and in the children themselves. Parents are encouraged to check that their children are wearing the correct school uniform prior to their departure for school.
